A census authorized by the city council has just been completed in Cantersville, and a careful count made by three of the prominent citizons who were detailed to take the census shows a gain of 200 souls ovr the figures made by the government enumerators. The count made by the citizens includes school figures also, which are given in detail below. Regular census taken by U. S. government gives Cartersville a opulation of 4,067. The special census just taken gives the city 4,227, which is an increase over the government figures of 100. The population as divided into wards as follows:
